We received about 150 patients in pediatric neurology outpatient clinic each month, where we deal with patients with seizure disorder, cerebral palsy, limb weakness , developmental disorders , follow up of patients with meningitis/encephalitis that were discharged from the hospital... etc.

I 'm a senior lecturer in Baghdad medical college giving lectures of pediatric development, neurology and also pediatric cardiology lectures (during 2008 and 2009 years) .

Since 2010 I started giving lectures about pediatric development and pediatric Neurology.

Since 2009 I joined the team in the neurology department [in Baghdad Teaching Hospital]. I started working with EEG in the outpatient clinic since 2011 in Baghdad Teaching Hospital.

Since 2012 - 2013, I joined the Paediatric Neurology Iraqi Board in the Iraqi Council of Medical Specialties. I had courses in the pediatric Neurology Unit, Adult Neurology Unit, EEG/EMG departments, Ophthalmology Clinic & Radiology Centre and graduated at November 2015.
